

Uncle Sam Will Spend Total 15 Billion Dollars

Nearly 20,000 Airplanes, Two-Ocean Navy And A Big Army

Washington.—President Roosevelt's \$15,000,000,000 preparedness program was sent "over the top" last Friday when the Senate joined the House in approving a \$5,351,486,392 "total defense bill," last segment of the long range program.

The chamber acted swiftly, without debate and with no record vote. The House gave final approval to the measure Thursday and it now goes to the White House for signature.

The bill releases funds for 18,421 warplanes, for starting construction of a two-ocean navy, and for establishment and mechanization of an army of 1,200,000 men.

It is the largest army-navy supply bill in the nation's peacetime history and boosts total defense appropriations and contract authorizations voted this year to approximately \$10,125,000,000. This figure does not include the \$4,125,000,000 naval expansion bill which is purely an authorization measure.

The measure retains a provision in existing law giving the secretary of the navy power to commandeer private plants and fix the compensation to be paid for them. The house yielded to the Senate on this point because the entire question of plant commandeering—either by the War and Navy Departments or the President—will be settled in the pending conscription bill.

Other major sections of the bill provide funds for reserve stocks of tanks, guns, artillery and ammunition for a second army of 800,000 men, if mobilization of such a force becomes necessary; \$100,000,000 for housing for defense workers; \$128,107,115 for construction of cantonments for mobilized national guardsmen.

It also contains \$201,000,000 for construction of flying fields and buildings at military posts throughout the U. S. and possessions and \$48,315,000 for projects at naval stations. Most of the army fund is for housing, part of which is designed to care for men to be drafted under the pending conscription bill.

Also in the bill a provision authorizing the secretary of war to enter into airplane contracts amounting to \$1,002,600,000 before next July 1.

It was expected that part of the equipment provided for in the measure would be used on the naval and air base sites acquired from Great Britain Tuesday in the trade for 50 over-age destroyers.

LaGuardia Gives Support To F.D.R.

Indianapolis. — Although acknowledging he had differed with Wendell L. Willkie over the proposed 60-day postponement of conscription, Chairman Joseph W. Martin Jr., of the Republican national committee, declared yesterday that congressional Republicans would cooperate with Willkie "after he becomes president."

With Senator Charles L. McNary, Willkie's running mate, and Governor Harold E. Stassen of Minnesota, Willkie and Martin luncheon conference here. Much of the session, Martin said, was devoted to details of Willkie's western speaking tour, on which the nominee left last night from Rushville, Ind.

Martin, talking with reporters after the conference, said that while some Republican congressmen "may differ with Mr. Willkie" on postponing conscription, "the country wants Congress to do some thinking of its own."

Willkie recently expressed hope that a House-approved amendment postponing conscription would be eliminated by a joint Senate-House conference committee. The committee took that action Wednesday.
