

Boiler Blast Kills Two Ashe Men

Went Jefferson.—Two men were instantly killed, another was critically injured and three others miraculously escaped injury in a sawmill boiler explosion in Ashe county early Friday morning.

Ronda "Ross" Worley and John Worley both of Todd are dead and Tommy Greer of the same community is in the Watauga General Hospital at Boone and is not expected to live.

The tragedy occurred in the Northfork township near the home of Dr. A. G. Sharpe.

Ronda Worley, who was oiling the engine next to the boiler, was thrown a distance of 315 feet while the boiler and firebox were blown an equal distance in the opposite direction.

Worley's body sailed over an apple tree and road and struck a rail fence. His neck was broken and the body severely burned and scalded.

John Worley was thrown about 20 feet and his head was crushed by a large piece of iron.

The sawmill belonged to George Greer of Todd. He and two others standing near the saw were not hurt.

People living within a radius of three miles heard the terrific explosion and many said their homes shook.

No one seemed to know the cause of the explosion. It was stated that the boiler was getting old and that cold water might have been turned into it too quickly.

The bodies of the two dead men were brought to a funeral home here but no funeral arrangements had been made late Friday.

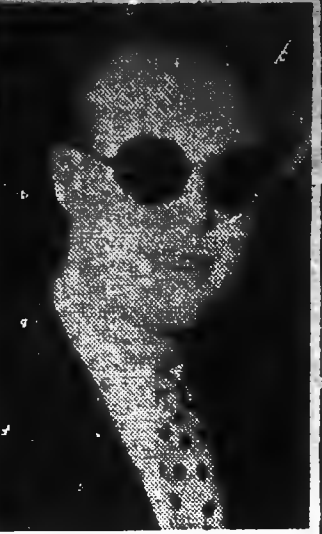
