

# And Test Case Assured Success

Dr. Dean James T. Assant And Serve As Resident Physician And Sept.

Raleigh.—Success of the North Carolina plan for securing voluntary serologic tests among those registering for the draft assured by 11 o'clock Wednesday, when, although material had been sent out for 90,000 such tests, 200,000 county health officers had either wired or telephoned the State Board of Health at Raleigh for additional tubes, stating that their supplies had been exhausted.

This announcement came from Dr. Carl V. Reynolds, State Health Officer, who is also chairman of the subcommittee of the Federal Relations Committee of the State and Territorial Health Officers' Association for making funds among the more than 16,000,000 who were expected to register Wednesday for the draft. Dr. Reynolds announced further that special runners were sent to Raleigh from at least a half dozen counties, including districts as far distant as 100 miles, for additional tubes and needles. Additional personnel was furnished by the NYA and the WPA to continue preparing and packaging supplies for distribution, he added.

"We find it absolutely essential to continue clinics, in order that the demand may be met," he went on. "This proves beyond the shadow of a doubt that the registrants are availing themselves of the grand opportunity that is being given them to take these tests. Where positive results are found they will be carried. I believe that North Carolina bids fair to ring up another 'first' in the execution of its plan which was adopted as a working model for all States wishing to avail themselves of it.

"The performance of this task on the part of the registrants will not only benefit those who are finally inducted into the armed forces of the nation, but the civil population as well, as it provides an excellent case finding and epidemiological study of the disease that causes the greatest number of casualties in war, with the exception of shot and shell.

"Much credit should be given Dr. J. C. Knox, State Epidemiologist, and his associates for planning, organizing and executing the program, and to Dr. John H. Hamilton, Director of the State Laboratory of Hygiene, and his associates, for the untiring efforts they have put forth in seeing that the material for making the tests was dispatched to the various counties. Their work will continue with perhaps increased momentum as the results of Wednesday's efforts are determined, as the blood specimens will, for the major part, be tested in the Laboratory of Hygiene and at laboratories approved by matter of clinic treatments Dr. this State Agency. Also, in the Knox and his staff have much work in store."

During the morning, Dr. Reynolds visited the Wake County Board of Health's clinic, in the old Rex Hospital building in Raleigh, where he saw Dr. A. C. Bulla, county health officer, working at capacity speed, in order to take care of the constant stream of registrants flocking to the building from all parts of the city.
