Senate Race Seen "In Bag" For Maybank

Columbia, S. C., Sept. 17. — Scattered returns from yesterday's Democratic primary to nominate a United States senator failed today to alter the results materially and Gov. Burnet R. Maybank appeared to have won the nomination over former Gov. Olin D. Johnston by a majority of more than 21,000 votes.

Latest unofficial returns from 1,407 of the state's 1,520 precincts gave Maybank 89,967 votes and Johnston 68,837.

Maybank, 42-year-old business man and former mayor of his native city, Charleston, said he probably would take office shortly after October 15.

Roger C. Peace, Greenville newspaper publisher, was appointed by the Governor to serve until that date, after Alva M. Lumpkin, of Columbia, appointed to the vacancy left by James F. Byrnes' elevation to the Supreme court, died less than two weeks after induction in July.

Lieut. Gov. J. E. Harley, a lawyer of Barnwell, will succeed Maybank as governor.

SOUTHERN HOSIERY MEN WILL CONVENE TONIGHT

Asheville, Sept. 17.—The annual meeting of the Southern Hosiery Manufacturers association will get under way with the banquet of the directors at Grove Park inn tomorrow evening, and sessions of the full association will start Friday morning at 10 o'clock.

Approximately 200 manufacturers from all over the south are expected for the gathering whose sessions will continue through Saturday.

Axis Bombers Attack Cairo For First Time

Cairo, Sept. 16.—Axis warplanes, in defiance of a British threat of retaliation against Rome, bombed Cairo for the first time early today, in an attack which killed 39 persons and wounded 93.

British, in a warning direct from the prime minister's residence in London, had on April 18 informed the axis that if either Athens or Cairo were bombed, reprisals would be carried out against Rome.

Further, it was stated that once the bombing of the Italian capital started it would "continue as convenient to the end of the war.")
