What Constitutes Proof Of Financial Responsibility

Proof of financial responsibility means proof of ability to pay 2-17-pd damages for liability thereafter incurred in the amount of \$5,-000 for injury to one person, \$10,000 for injury to two or more persons and \$1,000 for property damage.

How To Furnish Proof Of Financial Responsibility

Proof of financial responsibility may be furnished through the purchase of an automobile liability policy with limits as indicated in the preceding section or by posting cash, securities, or dress, or where you can be corporate bond in the amount of contacted. 


