

Five Local Men Enlist In Navy

R. L. Hogard, Chief Petty Officer in charge of the Navy recruiting office in North Wilkesboro, announced today that men interested in naval aviation, electronic technician, and many other specialized branches, are being accepted, if they are in all respects qualified.

Chief Hogard also stated that many of the war time rates are open to ex-navy men. You may re-enlist at the rate discharged provided that rate is listed as open.

Veterans May Enlist For European Duty

White former servicemen of the Army, Navy, Marines or Coast Guard may enlist in the United States Army for initial assignment to the European Command, provided they enlist in the grade of Staff Sergeant or lower, according to a statement made today by S.Sgt. Francis M. Darcy, commander of the Lenoir substation of the Army Recruiting Service located at the Post Office Building. This new enlistment directive became effective on August 1, 1947.

Enlistments for the European duty (including the Mediterranean Theatre) will be in the Regular Army unassigned for initial assignment to the European Command unassigned, and will be for periods of three, four, or five years.

Men enlisting under this directive who have been discharged more than 20 days will be ordered to the Fifth Infantry Division at Fort Jackson, where they will be reported as immediately available for shipment to the European Command. Men enlisting under this directive who have been discharged less than 20 days will be ordered direct to Camp Kilmer, N. J., for immediate shipment to Europe.

According to the Sergeant, this will be good news to many former servicemen who desire duty in Europe. For quite some time, now, the European Theatre has been closed to enlistments.
