Late summer and early fall seedings are preferred but many sful ladino clover pastures have been realized throughout the state when seeded in the spring, Mr. Dobson said. He pointed out that the chances of failure are greater in the spring and the yield the first year will be less, but it seems that where fall seeding was impossible there are cases where the need for grazing will justify taking the
