Apple Marketing Center Discussed

Members of the Agricultural committee of the Wilkes Chamber of Commerce and others interested met Tuesday afternoon at the Chamber of Commerce office to discuss apple marketing.

W. K. Sturdivant, committee chairman, presided, and others attending included: Paul Choplin, county agent; J. F. Woodward, superintendent of North Wilkesboro schools; C. B. Eller, superintendent of Wilkes schools; Carl Vandeman, manager of the freezer locker plant; R. M. Brame, Jr., chamber president; J. B. Williams, chamber past president; Tom S. Jenrette, chamber secretary-manager; and Paul Billings.

Data on selling apples to the U. S. Department of Agriculture for school lunches was discussed and it was announced that any apple producers interested in submitting bids before February 25 may get blanks and information from the chamber of commerce office, the freezer locker plant or from Lawrence Miller at the Triple A office. Apples will be

purchased in car lots. The discussion of an apple marketing center was interesting and it was proposed that a center be established where fruit growers may leave information as to what they have and buyers may also leave orders. It was suggested that the freezer locker plant be headquarters for this project.
