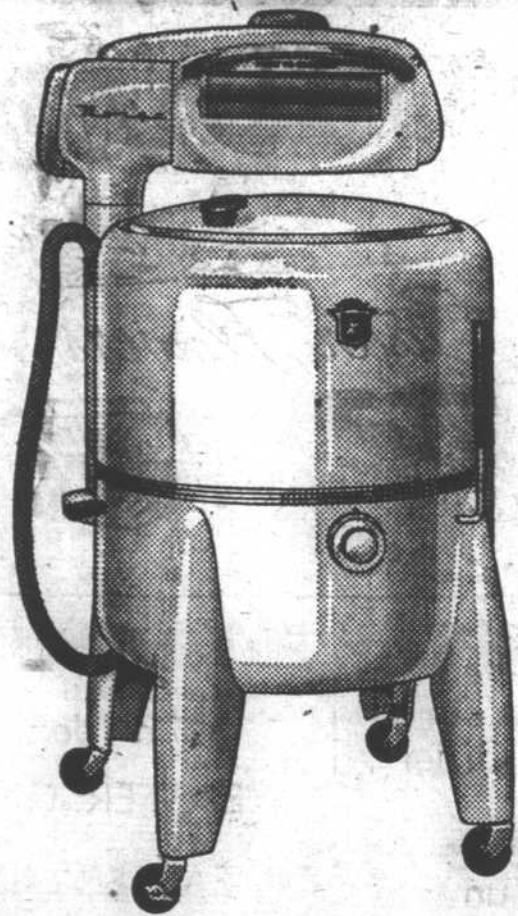

Legion To Give Four Scholarships

Raleigh, April 9.—Four scholarships of \$250.00 each will be awarded by the North Carolina Department of The American Legion for the year 1949-50, it was announced by Legion Department headquarters today.

The scholarships are open to any son or daughter of deceased Legionnaires of either World War I or World War II, actually in need of financial assistance to continue his education after finishing high school. The cause of the parents death is not a factor in determining eligibility for these scholarships but the deceased parent must have been a member of an American Legion Post in North Carolina sometime during his lifetime.

There is no special type of application to file for one of these scholarships, but applicant must be endorsed by the local post and must submit a statement from some person in the community showing that the applicant is a person of character, ability and ambition.

Deadline for the filing of requests for one of these scholarships is midnight June 30, 1949, and all requests should be completed and mailed in plenty of time to reach State American Legion headquarters, Box 2509, Raleigh, before that date. Further information may be obtained by contacting the local American Legion Post.

Fiddlers' Convention Union Grove 16th

Union Grove school will celebrate the Silver Anniversary of its Old Time Fiddlers' Convention on Easter Saturday night, April 16th.

This year the Union Grove Fiddlers' Convention, celebrates its silver anniversary. For twenty-five consecutive Easter Saturday nights throngs of people from far and near have been gathering at Union Grove to enjoy the old time music. Last year was the biggest ever. Over thirty bands participated, and over 1000 people were present for the gala occasion. Mr. H. P. Van Hoy, a veteran fiddler himself, has been manager of the convention since its beginning. He is an expert in this field and is in demand the country over for holding conventions of this kind. Only instrumental bands participate. The

fiddlers this year will entertain in three convention halls. Each hall will be equipped with loud speakers and comfortable seating arrangements. The musicians rotate from hall to hall so that everybody can see and hear the same program. The feature program will begin at eight o'clock p. m.

American Legion Will Assist In Filing Claims

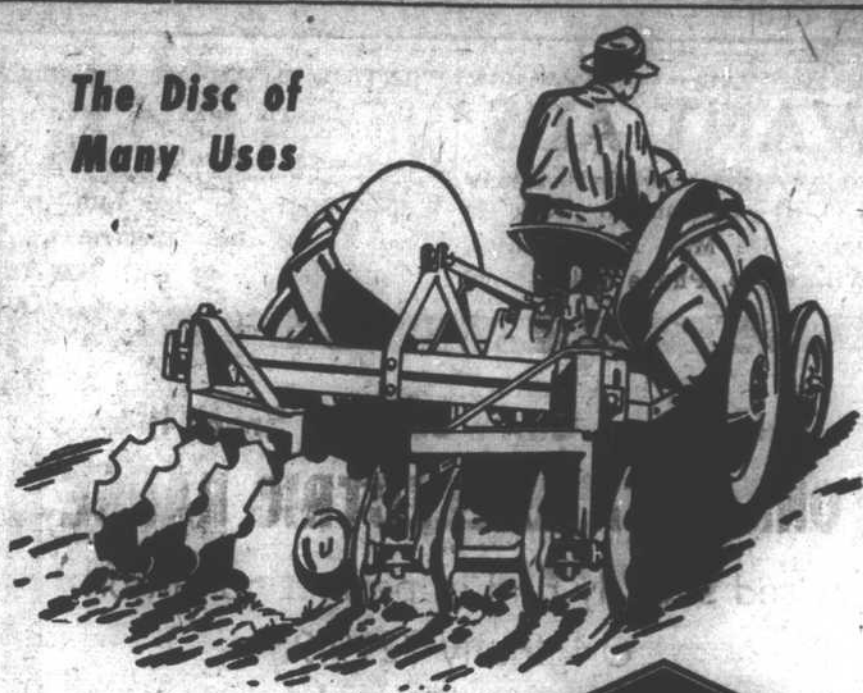

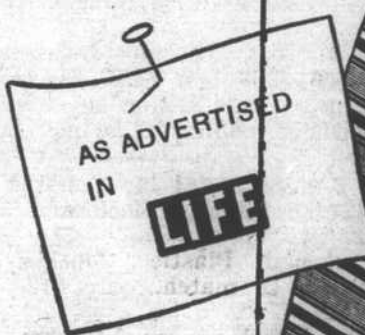
