Watauga County Centennial Soon

Plans for celebrating Watauga county's 100 years of existence have been tentatively worked out by the Watauga Centennial committee, according to an announcement this week by Stanley A. Harris, Committee Chairman. The six-day celebration has been set for July 5-10, and many notables from North Carolina and surrounding states are expected to visit the county and participate in the daily programs and the nightly performances of "Echoes of the Blue Ridge," a continuous mammoth spectacle dramatizing the county's history. The 100 years progress celebration will be staged on the athletic field of Appalachian State Teachers College.

The commemoration will begin July 5, with a day honoring Daniel Boone and other pioneers of the section.

The second day, July 6, will be Governor's Day. Governor Kerr Scott has been invited to speak in the afternoon and Governors from Tennessee, Virginia, Kentucky, Pennsylvania and Missouri, states in which Daniel Boone lived, have been invited.

In connection with Governor's Day, Ashe and Avery counties will be honored. Watauga originally was part of Ashe county. Avery county was, until 38 years ago, part of Watauga.

Education Day, July 7, will feature the Appalachian State Teachers College, which is half as old as the county. Education officials from this state and Tennessee, Virginia and South Carolina will be invited as special guests.

A special effort will be made for the return of those who were born or have lived in Watauga county to come back home on July 8.

July 9 will be Agriculture Day, when farmers of this section will be honored.

The last day of the celebration, Sunday, July 10, will be Worship Day, with the churches of the county joining together for a worship day. Old-time songs and hymns will be featured that day with a message from an outstanding minister, according to the tentative plans.

"Echoes of the Blue Ridge," a dramatization of the founding, settling and developing of Watauga County, will be a feature of the night activities during the celebration. More than 500 actors will take part in the show. The life of Daniel Boone and others who played a part in the Watauga's history will be portrayed.

A queen of the centennial will be selected; also a pioneer.

Airlift Operators Will Get Welcome

Washington.—Men who made the Berlin airlift possible are in for a hero's welcome back home. Plans for a big U. S. reception are being worked out at the national military establishment, but no announcement has been made yet.

It was learned that plans are in the works to bring home soon representative groups of air force and navy pilots, GI mechanics and truck drivers, and sailors and merchant mariners who manned ships transporting gasoline and supplies to the airlift's planes.

They would be taken on a nation-wide tour—probably by plane—so people everywhere could applaud the men who succeeded in air-supplying a major city for the first time in history.

Altogether, U. S. Planes made 127,969 flights into Berlin from bases in Western Germany carrying a total of 1,173,895 tons. Total miles flown add up to the amazing amount of 59,203,000.

This gigantic venture bypassing Russia's ground travel blockade cost the lives of 27 Americans—24 men in the air force, one in the navy, one army fire-truck driver, and one civilian.

Livestock breeders in the United States imported nearly 40 per cent more purebred animals during 1948 than in 1947. The majority of the importations were from Canada.

National average support prices of 69 cents a bushel for 1949 crop oats, \$1.27 for rye, \$1.09 for barley, and \$2.09 per 100 pounds for grain sorghums have been announced by the U. S. Department of Agriculture.

Preliminary estimates indicate that the expenses of marketing livestock during March, 1949, averaged 79 cents per 100 pounds, 10 per cent higher than in 1947. Expenses at markets increased about 4 per cent, and expenses for transportation were up about 13 per cent.
