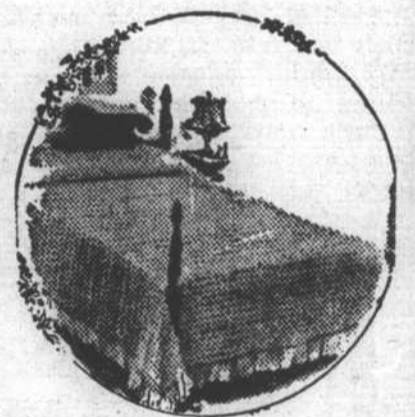
Funeral service will be held Friday, 2:30, at Hinshaw Street Baptist church.
