Chairman Clyde R. Hoey (Democrat, North Carolina) made the claim as his supervising committee opened an inquiry into alleged "kickback" practices among insurance brokers and freight forwarders.

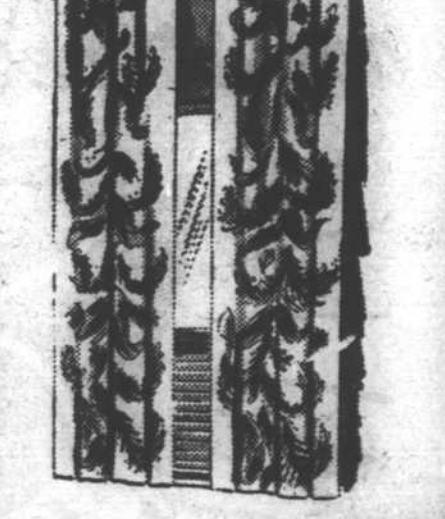

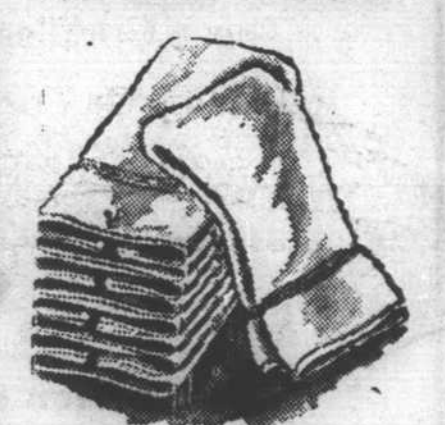
