Although losing, the Millers Creek eleven played well and during the second half led in offensive play, lacking the scoring punch near the goal line to pull the game out of the fire.

On the final play of the first quarter Millers Creek employed the old "Sleeper Pass Play" to score easily from the 35-yard line. Ray Church went into the game and was on the sideline far from the scrimmage point when Osborne shot him a pass. Church went over standing up but play for extra point into the line failed.

In the second period Crossnore pulled the old statute of liberty to set up a score. R. Burleson ran the ball 24 yards, going out of bounds just before crossing the goal line. From that point H. Aldridge scored, and C. Aldridge kicked the point.

In the third period Millers Creek threatened but the drive bogged on the 11.


