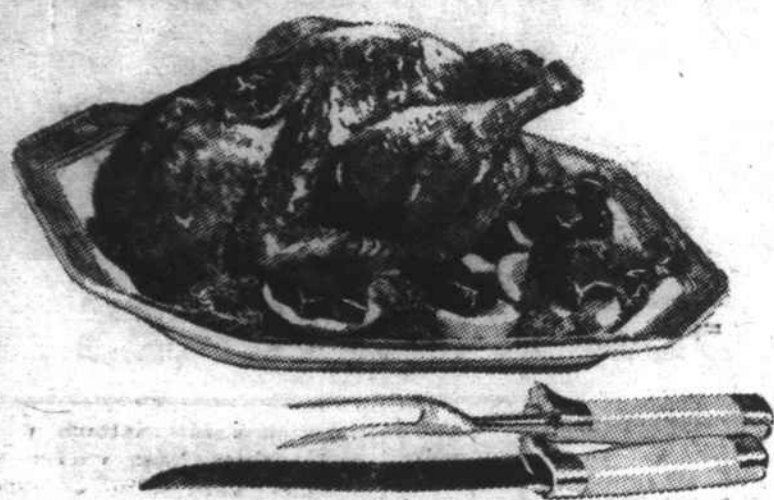

Mrs. Paige Rites Held Saturday

Mrs. Olo Clark Paige Dies Unexpectedly in Mooresville Hospital

Mrs. Olo Clark Paige, wife of Robert L. Paige, of Cornelius, died while undergoing an operation at a Mooresville Hospital, Thursday morning, November 10th. The operation was not considered a serious one and her death came as a shock to family and friends.

Mrs. Paige, a member of a very prominent Wilkes County family, was the former Helen Olo Clark, daughter of Mr. and Mrs. A. S. Clark, of Millers Creek. She was married to Robert L. Paige, of Greensboro, on August 24, 1943, but due to his being in the service, continued to make her home with her parents. During this time she was connected with Prevette's Women's Store. After her husband's discharge from the service, they made their home in Charlottesville, Va., later moving to Cornelius, where she lived at the time of her death.

Mrs. Paige was born March 24, 1919, her age at death being 30 years, 7 months, 16 days. She joined Pleasant Home Baptist church at the age of 15 years, and had been a devout church member, having moved her membership to each locality in which she lived. She was also a member of the Mecklenburg Chapter of the Eastern Star, in which she took a very active part and was a valued member.

Surviving Mrs. Paige are her husband, Robert L., one daughter, Barbara Lynn, age 2, her parents, Mr. and Mrs. A. S. Clark and the following brothers and sisters: Fred R. Clark of Charlotte, N. C., Wake Clark and Mrs. Jimmie Tolbert of

Millers Creek, Mary Hester, Bill, Shirley and Kate Clark, of the home.

The body was returned to the home of her parents Friday and funeral services were held at Pleasant Home Baptist church Saturday afternoon, November 12 at 2:00 o'clock. The service was conducted by Dr. John T. Wayland and Rev. A. W. Eller. The Mecklenburg Chapter of the Eastern Star participated in the grave side rites. Prior to the service the body lay in state at the church for one hour.

Mrs. Paige was well-liked and known throughout the county and made many friends wherever she chose to live. She was especially devoted to her mother and family. The esteem in which she was held was proven by the beautiful floral offerings, which were carried by around fifty of her friends.

Chicken Dinner At Mount Pleasant Thanksgiving Day

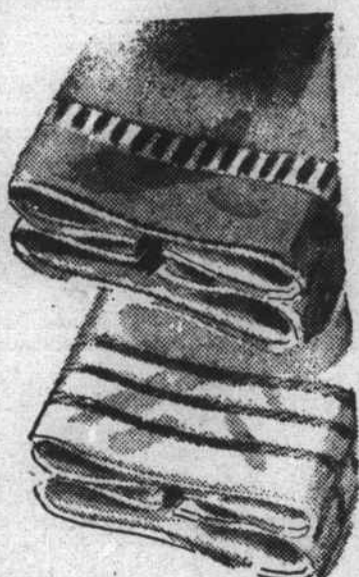
