Lenoir, Dec. 1.—Ralph Penuell, 55, was convicted today by a jury on a charge of second degree manslaughter in connection with the fatal shooting of Clarence Russell, 29.

Pennell and Russell lived in the King's Creek community. The shooting took place at Pennell's home on midnight, October 25, evidence showed.

A jury in Caldwell Superior Court deliberated 30 minutes be-fore reaching its verdict.
