Wilkesboro high school boys defeated one of the strongest teams of the Highland conference at Wilkesboro Tuesday night when they bumped off the fast-stepping Sparta boys 39 to 31. It was the sixth straight victory for the Wilkesboro boys since the Christmas holidays.

Sparta girls, continuing their unbeaten pace, downed the Wilkesboro girls 53 to 28, Jarvis with 12 and Byrd with 10 led Wilkesboro scoring.

Dean Edwards ran up 15 points for Wilkesboro to continue his high scoring pace and John Garwood hit for the same number as he was highly accurate on set shots. The Ramblers had rolled up a 26 to 15 lead by half time, withstood a Sparta surge in the third period and went on to win.

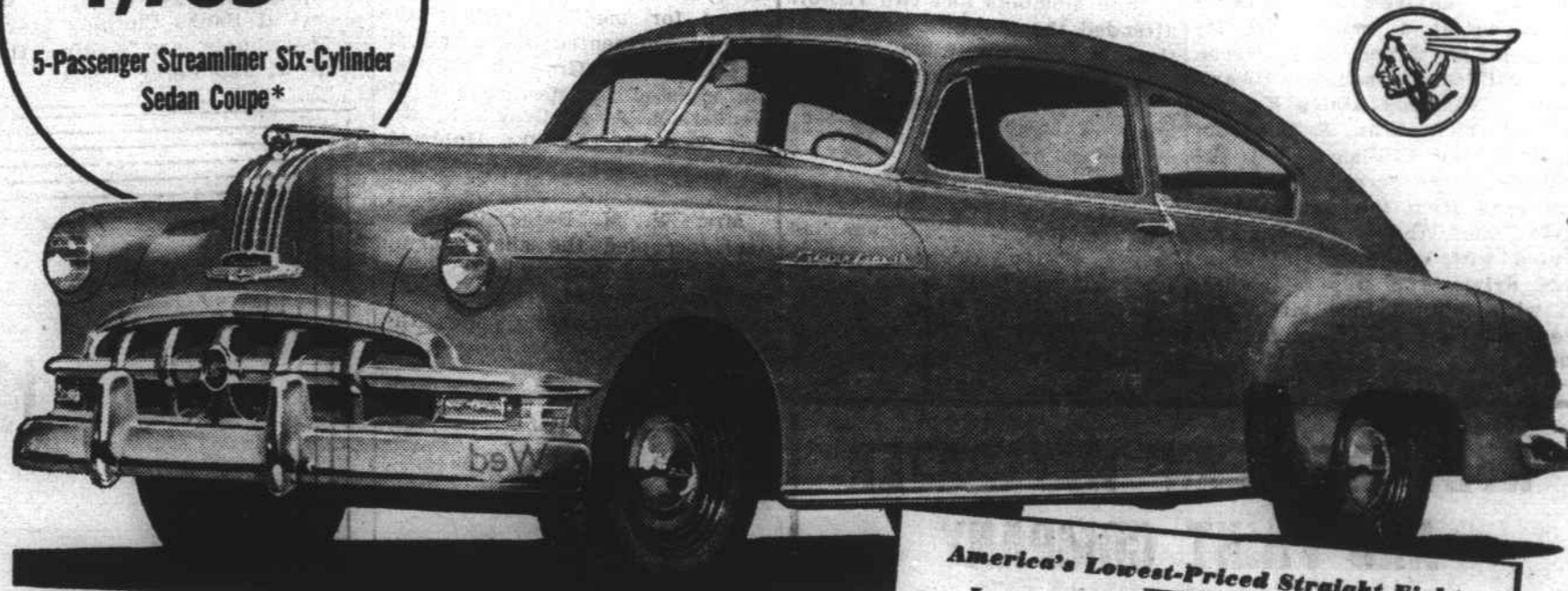
