PMA Pasture Seed Regulations Explained

Lawrence Miller, Chairman of the Wilkes County PMA Committee stated today that several farmers in the county are under the impression that seed may be purchased and applied to pasture with the seed tickets later being turned in to the county PMA office and credit received. In other words, that the farmer might receive partial payment later on in the season.

Mr. Miller explained that under the present set-up, the program is a prior approval program. The farmer must go by the county office and declare the practice that he intends to carry out before the practice is carried out. Pasture grass cannot be purchased, neither can winter cover seed be purchased, until the farmer has declared his intention of using these seed for pasture or win-
