WILLIE RECTOR FACES YEAR OF PRISON BEFORE PAROLE

Raleigh, June 6 — Before Willie Rector can be considered for parole, he may have to serve at least a year in prison.

That was the word given to Rector's wife, his two small children, and representatives of the company he worked for by Paroles Commissioner T. C. Johnson today.

Convicted Of Rape
Rector, a convicted rapist, escaped and eventually settled down in Chattanooga, Tenn., where he raised a family and became a trusted employe of the Central Motor Express company. He used the name Marshall Evans.

Johnson told the pleading group that it is the general policy of the paroles office that an escaped prisoner must serve one-fourth of the remainder of his term before being considered for parole. He pointed out that Rector has about 19 years of his term remaining.

Rector escaped six years ago. Prison records show that he received a death sentence in Burke county in 1931 on a charge of rape. This was commuted to life imprisonment and in 1939 his sentence was commuted to 30 years.

Later the couple left for a motor trip to points of interest in western North Carolina and Tennessee. They are now at home at Summit.

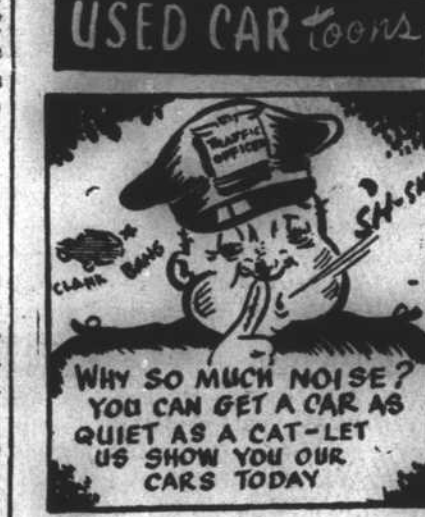
