Miss. Eloise Starr Entertains Her Club

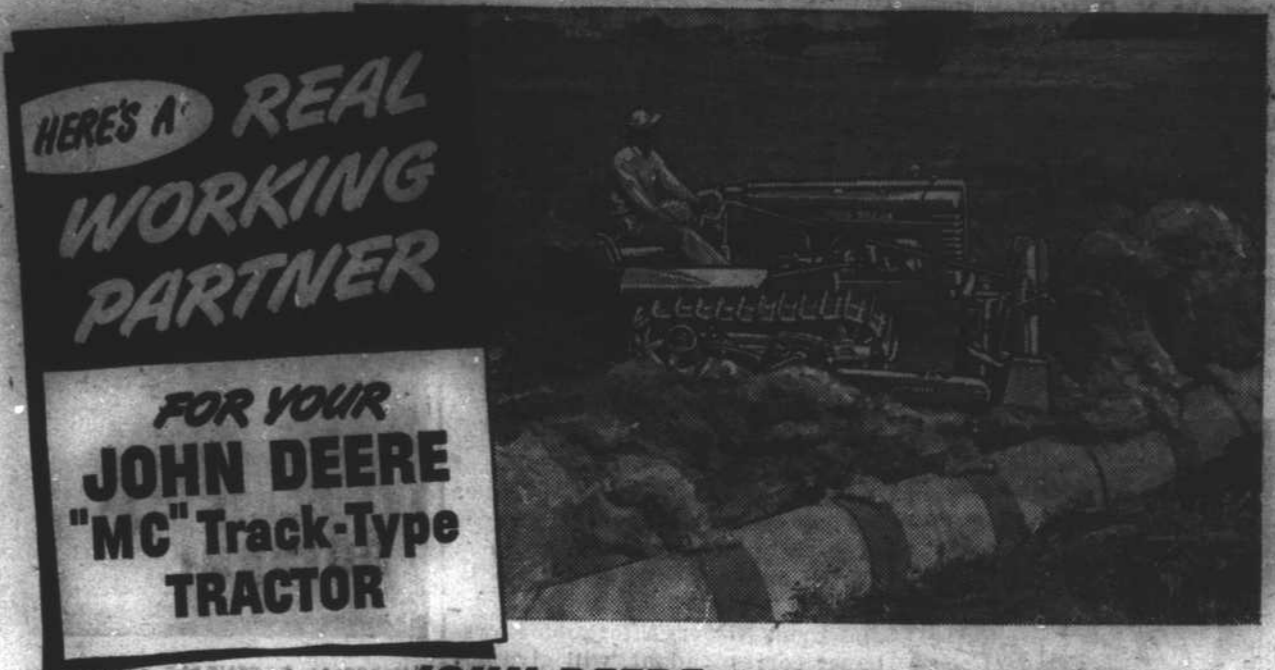
A delightful club meeting was the one given Friday evening when Miss Eloise Starr entertained for

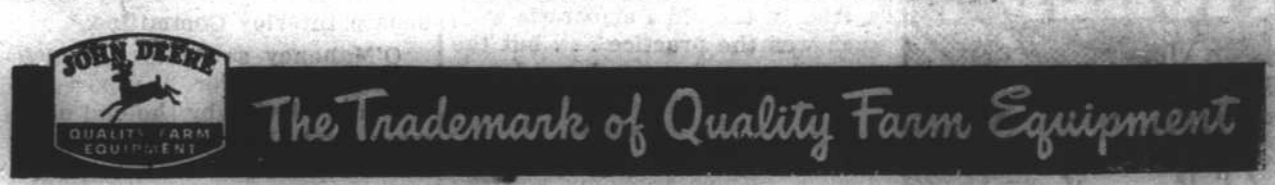
