WHIG MEETING IN BLADEN. Pursuant to previous notice, a large and highly enthusiastic portion of the Whigs of Bladen met in the Court House in Elizabethton, on Monday, the 6th of February, to appoint delegates to represent the county in the Whig State Convention to be held in Raleigh, on the 21st of the present month. John Smith, Esq., was called to the Chair, and Jno. A. Richardson was chosen Secretary.

WHIG MEETING IN DAVIE. A Meeting of the Whigs of Davie County was held in the Court House in Monticello, on Saturday the 4th instant. On motion of Dr. D. C. Parker, the meeting was organized by calling Col. J. B. Jones, to the Chair, and appointing G. A. Kingham, Secretary. The object of the meeting having been explained by the Chairman, Col. J. A. Linton introduced the following resolutions, which were unanimously adopted.

WHIG MEETING IN STOKES. A meeting of a portion of the Whigs of Stokes was held in the town of Danbury on the 1st inst. for the purpose of appointing delegates to attend the Whig State Convention to be held in Raleigh on the 21st of February, 1854. On motion of A. H. Joyce, Dr. Wm. W. Moore was called to the Chair, and Gideon E. Cole was appointed to act as Secretary. The object of the meeting having been explained by the Chairman, an informal committee of five to draft resolutions expressive of the sense of the meeting, were unanimously adopted.

WHIG MEETING IN CAMDEN. Pursuant to notice, the Whigs of Camden County assembled in the Court House of said County on Tuesday the 13th day of December, 1853, and upon motion Timothy C. Chambers, Esq., was called to the Chair, and Wm. W. Sawyer was appointed Secretary. After taking his seat, the Chairman called on Mr. D. D. Ferber to explain the object of the meeting, which was accordingly done; and in conclusion his remarks, Mr. Ferber offered the following preamble and resolutions.

WHIG MEETING IN RANDOLPH. At a meeting of a portion of the Whigs of Randolph County, held on the 8th day of Feb. 1854, in the Court House in Asheboro, on motion of Jonathan Worth, Esq., the Hon. John Long was called to the Chair; and on motion of Col. J. M. A. Drake, Alfred G. Foster was requested to act as Secretary. A Committee, consisting of William J. Long, John B. Troy and Jonathan Worth, Esq., having been appointed to prepare resolutions, the consideration of the meeting, retired for that purpose.
