RECONSTRUCTION. AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR THE MORE EFFICIENT GOVERNMENT OF THE REBEL STATES.

GENERAL ORDERS. THE CAROLINAS. ORDER FROM GEN. SICKLES FOR THE RELIEF OF THE DISTRICTS.

THE NUMBER OF SUCH LICENSES SHALL BE DETERMINED, AND THE FEES TO BE CHARGED FOR EACH LICENSE, SHALL BE PRESCRIBED AND COLLECTED BY THE MUNICIPAL OR TOWN AUTHORITIES.

SECTION 1. All persons born or naturalized in the United States and subject to the jurisdiction thereof are citizens of the United States and of the state where they reside.

SECTION 2. That after the completion of the registration hereby provided for in any State at such time and places therein as the commanding general, shall appoint and direct of which at least thirty days notice shall be given.

All elections in the States mentioned in the said "Act to provide for the more efficient government of the rebel States," shall, during the operation of said act, be held, during the operation of said act, by the commanding general, and the commanding general shall prescribe the fees, salary, and compensation to be paid to all delegates and other officers and agents herein authorized or necessary to carry into effect the purposes of this act.
