STATE BOARD OF EDUCATION. The Governor, Lieutenant-Governor, Secretary of State, Treasurer, Auditor, Superintendent of Public Works, Superintendent of Public Instruction and Attorney General, constitute the State Board of Education.

SUPREME COURT. The Supreme Court consists of a Chief Justice and four Associate Justices. There are two terms of the Court held in Raleigh in January, and the first Monday in June and continuing as long as the public interests may require.

GENERAL ASSEMBLY. The General Assembly commences its annual session on the third Monday in November in each year, and is composed of fifty Senators and one hundred and twenty Representatives, biennially chosen, by ballot, on the first Thursday in August.

SUPERIOR COURTS. There are twelve Judicial Districts and twelve Judges. Every Judge of a Superior Court must reside in his District. Judges may exchange Districts with the consent of the Governor.

SOLICITORS—Elected by the people. Term of office four years. 1st District—J. W. Albertson. 2d do Joseph J. Martin.
