PUBLIC ACTS.

1. An Act concerning Original Attachments. (Allows Clerks of the County and Superior Courts to issue Original Attachments, and allows the same fees as in suits commencing by writ.)

2. An Act to incorporate the Greenville and Raleigh Plank Road Company. (Provides for making a Plank Road from the town of Greenville to Raleigh with a capital of \$250,000, in shares of \$25 each, the Charter to continue in force for 50 years; the stock to be owned by private individuals.)

3. An Act to amend the 14th Section, 19 Chapter of an act passed at the General Assembly of 1848-49, concerning the late County of Polk. (Directs that P. B. Williams, late Sheriff of Polk County, pay 1/2 of the Common School funds in his hands to the Chairman of the Board of Superintendents of Common Schools for Rutherford County, and the remainder to the Chairman &c. of Henderson County; and, in default, to be liable to the pains and penalties of defaulting public officers.)

4. An Act authorizing the Seaboard and Roanoke Railroad Company to issue bonds (Authorizes the Company to issue bonds, under its seal, to the amount of \$400,000, in sums of \$1,000 each, to bear interest at 7 per cent, payable semi-annually; the principal payable, in the city of New York, in \$50, with a mortgage on the road and its works as security for the same.)

5. An Act to incorporate the Fayetteville and Southern Plank Road Company. (Incorporates a Company with a capital not to exceed \$25,000, in shares of \$50 each, to construct a Plank Road from the town of Fayetteville to or near Lincolnton Bridge Church in the County of Robeson; the stock to be owned by individuals.)

6. An Act to lay off and establish a new County by the name of Yadkin. (Provides for the establishment of a new County out of that portion of Surry south of the Yadkin, to be called by the name of Yadkin, to be known as Little Surry, an addition, however, that the people of Surry shall continue, by a majority of their votes, the establishment of such new County.)

7. An Act to incorporate the Fayetteville and Centre Plank Road Company. (Provides for constructing a Plank Road from the town of Fayetteville to Centre in Stanly County, with a capital of \$120,000, in shares of \$50 each; the stock to be owned by individuals, with power to increase the capital stock to a sum not exceeding \$300,000, by opening books in Fayetteville and other places.)

8. An Act to extend the time of perfecting titles to lands heretofore entered. (Extends the time of perfecting titles to January 1853.)

9. An Act concerning Jury trials in the County of Guilford. (Resolves jury trials to the County Court of said County.)

10. An Act to repeal an act entitled "An act to amend an act to incorporate the Hickory Nut Turnpike Company passed at the session of the General Assembly of 1848-49."

11. An Act to regulate the pay of Jurors and Witnesses in the County of Craven. (Provides that Jurors and Witnesses shall receive \$1.50 per day, and the like sum for every 20 miles traveling.)

12. An Act to change the name of the County of Stokes and for other purposes. (Changes the name of Craven.)

13. An Act to amend an act entitled "An act to amend the 14th section of the Revised Statutes, passed at the session of the Legislature of 1848-49, entitled 'An act to amend an act to incorporate the McDowell and Yadon Turnpike Company.'"

14. An Act to amend an act to incorporate the McDowell and Yadon Turnpike Company. (Provides for \$3,000 gratuitous subscription, and if there is any deficiency, the County Courts of McDowell and Yadon are to raise it by taxation. The Literary Board to subscribe \$3,000 when the preceding \$3,000 has been secured.)

15. An Act to give a name to the County of Forsyth and for other purposes. (Gives it the name of Winston.)

16. An Act to repeal a portion of an act entitled "An act authorizing the Seaboard and Roanoke Railroad Company to issue bonds," passed at the present session of the General Assembly. (Repeals so much of the above recited act as requires the third section of the same to be ratified by the State of Virginia.)

17. An Act to amend the third section of an act passed at the present session of the General Assembly entitled "An act to incorporate the Fayetteville and Southern Plank Road Company."

18. An Act to revise so much of the Revised Statutes Chapter 34, Sections 1, 2, 7 and 32 as may have been repealed by the acts of 1846 entitled "An act to prevent more effectually the corruption of slaves population."

19. An Act to incorporate the Bank of Washington in the County of Beaufort. (Incorporates a bank with a capital of \$400,000, in shares of \$50 each.)

20. An Act to re-charter the Merchant's Bank of Newberne.

21. An Act concerning Corporations.

22. An Act to incorporate the Tennessee Railroad Company in the County of Macon. (Incorporates a Company with a capital of one million of dollars, to construct a Rail Road from the point where the line of the State of Tennessee crosses the Tennessee River, to the point where the line of the State of Georgia crosses the same river, near Franklin in Macon County.)

23. An Act to give the benefit of appeals to all suits except in capital cases. (Prohibits from refusing to admit to bail persons arrested on criminal offenses, except in capital cases.)

24. An Act to provide for a geological and mineralogical survey of the State. (Makes an annual appropriation of \$5,000 for that purpose.)

25. An Act to amend the 31st section of the 10th Chapter of the Revised Statutes. (Requires Sheriff, or other sales of lands in some newspapers published or circulated in the county in which the lands lie.)

26. An Act to incorporate the Mechanics Savings Society of Weldon.

27. An Act to incorporate the Mechanics Savings Society of Jackson.

28. An Act to amend an act entitled "An act to amend an act passed in the year one thousand and thirty three entitled an act to incorporate

the Wilmington and Raleigh Rail Road Company."

29. An Act to facilitate the taking of testimony before Referees, Arbitrators and Commissioners.

30. An Act to amend the Constitution of North Carolina. (Commonly known as the "free suffrage" act.)

31. An Act to divide the regiment of Militia in Stokes County.

32. An Act to incorporate the Garysburg and Oconeechee Plank Road Company. (Incorporates a company with a capital of \$25,000, in shares of \$50 each.)

33. An Act in respect to the payment of the original panel of jurors of Beaufort County.

34. An Act authorizing the Justices of the County of Pleas and Quarter Sessions of the County of Warren to sell certain property belonging to said County.

35. An Act to restore jurisdiction to the County Courts of Yadon and Henderson Counties.

36. An Act supplemental to an act passed by the present General Assembly entitled an act to lay off and establish a new County by the name of Yadkin.

37. An Act to amend "an act to establish the Bank of Fayetteville" passed at the last session of the General Assembly.

38. An Act to amend an act entitled "an act to incorporate the Caldwell and Ashe Turnpike Company," passed by the General Assembly at its session of 1846-47.

39. An Act to authorize the laying off and improving a public road from the town of Jefferson in the County of Ashe to the Virginia line, near James L. Hall's.

40. An Act to amend an act passed at the Session of the General Assembly of 1848-49 entitled "an act to incorporate the Greensboro and Mt. Airy Turnpike Company."

41. An Act in relation to the execution of Criminal process.

42. An Act to regulate the fishing with seines in North River in the counties of Camden and Currituck.

43. An Act for the better regulation of the town of Wilson in Edgecombe County.

44. An Act to incorporate the Albemarle and Currituck Company.

45. An Act to extend the corporate limits of the town of Elizabeth City in the County of Pasquotank.

46. An Act to incorporate the Tackles and Nonahatchee Turnpike Company. (Incorporates a company with a capital of \$5,000 in shares of \$5 each.)

47. An Act to provide relief for purchasers of Cherokee lands, secure debts due to the State and authorize the sale of lands surrendered to the State by the acts of 1844-45 and 1846-47.

48. An Act in respect to the payment of the original panel of jurors for the County of Craven.

49. An Act to amend an act for the incorporation of the town of Wilmington, Chap. 189 of the acts of the Session of 1840.

50. An Act to incorporate the Milton Savings Institute.

51. An Act to repeal an act passed in 1846-47 entitled "an act to provide for the opening and clearing out certain Creeks in the counties of Iredell and Rowan."

52. An Act to enlarge the powers of the Commissioners of Wilmington.

53. An Act to lay off and establish a new County by the name of Hoper.

54. An Act authorizing Josiah O. Watson to construct a dam on Neuse River.

55. An Act to amend the 7th section of the 3th Chapter of the Revised Statutes, in relation to apprentices.

56. An Act authorizing the transfer of Books, Bonds &c., from the Treasurer's Office to the agent of the State for the collection of Cherokee land bonds.

57. An Act to authorize Jas. S. Turner to build a toll bridge across Rocky River in Stanley and Anson Counties.

58. An Act to incorporate the Bank of Wadesboro'. (Capital \$200,000, shares \$50 each.)

59. An Act to amend the 119th section of the 31st Chapter of the Revised Statutes, entitled "Courts, County and Superior."

60. An Act to incorporate the Roanoke Valley Railroad Company. (The Road to extend from Clarksville, Va., to some point on the Raleigh and Gaston Railroad at or near Redway.)

61. An Act to incorporate the Central and Newbern Railroad. (The Road to be built between Newbern and Goldsboro'. Capital \$500,000 to be taken by individuals.)

62. An Act to amend an act entitled "an act to protect the interests of lessors," passed at the session of 1840-41.

63. An Act to incorporate the Tackles and Keowee Turnpike Company. (Company to be considered incorporated when \$2,000 are subscribed.)

64. An Act to incorporate the Anson Plank Road Company. (Capital \$75,000 in shares of \$50 each.)

65. An Act to extend the right of appeal.

66. An Act to incorporate the Western Plank Road Company. (Incorporates a company to construct a Plank Road from Charlotte, through Lincoln to Newton, with a capital of \$200,000 in shares of \$50 each, by private subscription.)

67. An Act concerning depositions.

68. An Act to repeal so much of an act entitled "an act to open and improve the trail from Salathiel Stone's old place in the County of Forsythe to the Virginia line near the mouth of Wilson, in Ashe County as applies to the County of Forsythe."

69. An Act to prevent more effectually the corruption of slaves population.

70. An Act to appoint Commissioners to view and buy off a public road from the town of Fayetteville in the County of Alexander to Aquila Payne's in Caldwell County and for the purpose of improving the same.

71. Concerning Pilots.

79. An Act to incorporate the Neuse River Navigation Company. (Incorporates a com-

pany with a capital of \$100,000 in shares of \$100 each, to improve the Navigation of the Neuse River from Newbern to Watson's Landing.)

79. An Act to appoint Commissioners to view and buy off a road from the town of Marion in McDowell County, crossing the Blue Ridge at Buck Creek Gap and thence to the Tennessee line at the top of Iron Mountain.

80. An Act for the regulation of the inspection of Tar.

81. An Act allowing decrees of Courts of Equity in certain cases to transfer legal title.

82. An Act authorizing the Clerks of the Superior Courts to take bonds when they issue writs of *recoverture* and *return*.

83. An Act to incorporate the Raleigh and Gaston Rail Road Company. (Provides for the incorporation of a company to put in repair the Raleigh and Gaston Rail Road. The old Stockholders are to be released from their liabilities to the State whenever they subscribe or procure to be subscribed \$400,000 and pay it in, and the State to have half of the stock of the road.)

84. An Act concerning Depositions.

85. An Act to improve the Deep River and the Yadkin River and to connect the two rivers by means of a Portage Rail Road. (Incorporates a Company for that purpose with a capital not to exceed \$800,000 in shares of \$200,000 in shares of \$100 each, to improve said river. The stock to be taken by individuals.)

86. An Act to incorporate the Charlotte and Taylorsville Plank Road Company. (Incorporates a company with a capital of \$800,000 in shares of \$50 each, the stock to be owned by individuals.)

87. An Act to incorporate the Yadkin Navigation Company to improve the Yadkin River with a capital \$200,000, the stock to be owned by individuals.)

88. An Act to amend an act entitled "an act to incorporate the Caldwell and Ashe Turnpike Company," passed by the General Assembly at its session of 1846-47.

89. An Act to require purchasers to pay the fees for inspecting turpentine.

90. An Act to authorize the investment of trust funds in the bonds and certificates of the State.

91. An Act supplemental to the several Plank Road Charters passed at the present session of the General Assembly.

92. An Act to amend the 4th section of the 12th Chapter of the Revised Statutes, concerning Bastard Children.

93. An Act to amend an act passed at the session of 1848-49 entitled "an act to establish a board of Directors for the Deaf and Dumb Institute in this State."

94. An Act to amend an act passed at the session of 1848-49 entitled "an act to amend the act now in force on the subject of Common Schools."

95. An Act to amend an act of the General Assembly of North Carolina passed at its session of 1848-49 entitled "an act more effectually to prevent the selling or giving away spiritous liquors at or near places of public worship."

96. An Act to incorporate the Wilmington and Topsail Sound Plank Road Company. (Incorporates a company with a capital of \$50,000 in shares of \$50 each, the stock to be owned by individuals.)

97. An Act to amend the 8th Chapter of the Revised Statutes. (Gives the Commissioners of navigation the power to make such regulations as may be necessary to prevent slaves attempting to escape in vessels from doing the same.)

98. To improve the navigation of Ruff Swamp Creek in the County of Robeson.

99. To alter and amend an act passed by the General Assembly at the session of 1848-49, entitled "an act to incorporate the Fayetteville and Western Plank Road Company."

100. To repeal an act of the General Assembly of 1848-49 providing for the support of a system of International Literary and Scientific Exchanges.

101. Authorizing the Board of Superintendents of the Common Schools for Bertie County to lend out the School fund in their hands.

102. To amend the 20th section of the Revised Statutes, Executors and Administrators, chap. 46.

103. Supplemental to the several Plank Road Charters that have been passed at the present General Assembly.

Many other articles are taxed which we have not room to notice. Repeals the tax on droves of hogs, horses, and mules.)
