Raleigh, November 28, 1854. SENATE. The Speaker presented the report of the Commissioners for the revision of the Statutes, which was ordered to be sent to the House of Commons with a proposition to refer it to the joint committee raised for that purpose.

Mr. Jones introduced a resolution, instructing the Committee on Education and the Literary Fund, to inquire into the propriety of providing for holding a school in each county of the State to ascertain the will of the people upon increasing the fund for the Common Schools by additional taxation, and providing for such taxation in those counties that vote for it, which was adopted.
