Truman Signs Bill For Pay Increases To Postal Workers

WASHINGTON, July 9 -(AP)-President Truman has signed legislation giving postal employes their first general pay raise since

For regular postal employes in so-called automatic grades, the legislation provides a 20 percent increase in base pay, or \$400 a year, whichever is the lesser. In no event will the raise be less than \$300.

It provides for overtime pay-ment at the rate of time and onehalf for time worked in excess of a basic 260-workdays annually, the differential of ten percent for em-ployes who work regularly at night.
