Assuming that it requires 2-3 lbs. of corn to make 1 lb. of pork, the cost of its production will be seen from the following table. The labor of feeding and taking care of the hogs is not included in the estimate.

When corn costs 12 1/2c. per bushel, pork costs 1 1/2c. per lb.; at 17c. per bushel, 2c. per lb.; at 22c. per bushel, 2 1/2c. per lb.; at 27c. per bushel, 3c. per lb.; at 32c. per bushel, 3 1/2c. per lb.; at 37c. per bushel, 4c. per lb.; at 42c. per bushel, 4 1/2c. per lb.

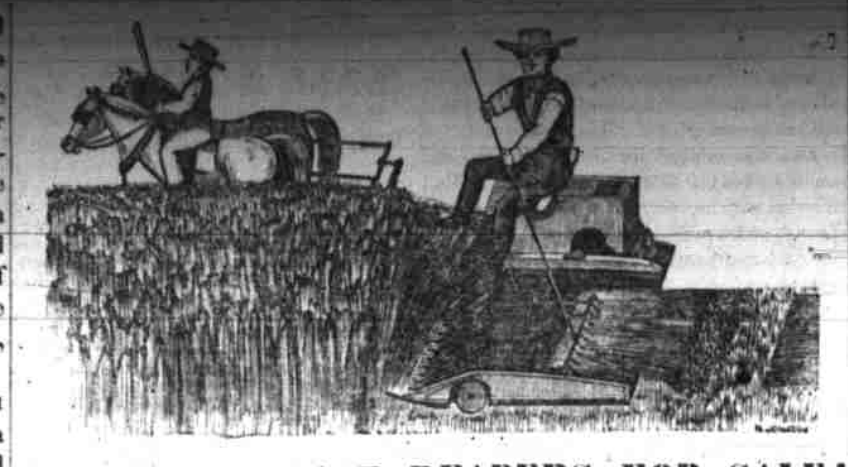
