

REMARKABLE EVENT.

Mortality of Children.—M. Berillon, in a recent letter addressed to the Academy of Medicine in Paris, has published some curious statistical facts concerning the mortality of infants under one year of age. Within a period of ten years there have been about 9,700,000 births in France, and 1,500,000 deaths under the specified age; so that out of 1000 new born infants, only 840 are destined to arrive the first twelve months.
