CRIME AT THE CAPITAL.

The Captain of the Police of Washington, D. C., has made his report for the month of December, which makes up a melancholy picture of the state of morals at the seat of government. A large portion of the crimes are attributed to intemperance; this vice was particularly apparent among the police, the army, and the clergy during the holidays.

The Report says that there has been a great increase in the number of crimes of the city during the month of December, 25 of whom were arrested for stealing, and 401 for various minor offences. The relation of this matter, as far as could be ascertained, was as follows: District of Columbia, 138; Ireland, 92; Virginia, 40; England, 31; Vermont, 13; Germany, 14; Kentucky, 1; Connecticut, 1; Scotland, 2; Delaware, 1; Massachusetts, 1; Maine, 1; Ohio, 3; Italy, 2; Mississippi, 1; Louisiana, 1; Georgia, 1; New Jersey, 1; Switzerland, 1; North Carolina, 1; White males, 208; colored males, 212; white females, 20; colored females, 22.
