

MORE OF MR. EVERETT.

The Governor of this Commonwealth has announced, unceremoniously, in the AP-FIRMATIVE, to the question (Mr. Everett's) whether he is in favor of the immediate abolition of slavery in the District of Columbia, the same trade language as he has used in the past.

In the same paper, an anti-slavery ticket is proposed by EDWARD EVERETT for Governor. From the Liberator of November 16, 1859, edited by William Lloyd Garrison.

We find the above in the Charlotte Bulletin of the 17th Aug, instant; and have only to remark that it would have been easy to give Mr. Everett's answer, and not the Liberator's comments on that answer. Please show Mr. Everett's answer to Borden's questions.

But opposing the case to be just as the foregoing would indicate, has Mr. Everett's subsequent public career, in the various stations he has filled since 1839, proven that he is willing to promote these sentiments! On the contrary has not every act of his public life proven him to be a Constitution-loving, and fast abiding man as regards Southern rights and interests? We defy any one to show the contrary.

It is within our recollection when many of our best men and women in North Carolina were anti-slavery in sentiment. They regarded it as a moral, social and political evil. But the subject has been more thoroughly examined since then, and the light of history, experience and revelation has proven that the ordinations of God are right and good, however severe to man's imperfect wisdom.
