The about suggestions are good, and we can see nothing to hinder their adoption in any community—every citizen's duty in the State is to organize a vigilance system within a month's time. It is undoubtedly true that some who are in the will attempt to "punch" the Southern States, and they will most likely attempt to operate in the country. In communities remote from the towns and villages and of the lines of travel and without some such system as that proposed above, they may evade detection long enough to put on foot little neighborhood troubles. No one believes for a moment that any extensive scheme could possibly be effected, and it is not from any apprehension of that sort that the writer of the above submits his plan; but simply for the maintenance of peace and security of families and neighborhoods. And in this view of the case, we think every family should also form a Vigilance Committee; and when they see a stranger in their neighborhood, let them look at the clock—note the very minute—note his dress—his height—the color of his hair and whiskers—his words—the direction he takes coming and going, and all about him; and if opportunity offers, as, for instance, stopping for dinner, or staying all night, ascertain where he is from, and what his object. No honest man, in times like these, will object to being probed with questions. And in any anything suspicious is seen in such a one, he should immediately be reported to the nearest magistrate, who would doubtless take such action as the case requires. And in all this, it is not necessary to make any fuss. Do it quietly, but with resolution and firmness. When a man has been arrested, treat him kindly, but stand him over to the proper authorities, and show him the matter test.
