4 p.m.—The Southern troops are still in position, and the Federals are retreating down the hill. The Federals are moving to the right and to the left, but no indication of a retreat is discernible.

From the Seat of War—Another Battle—Terrible Slaughter—Sherman's Battery—The Day is Ours Again.

Raleigh, July 21, 1861.

An engagement commenced near Monroe this morning at 6 a.m. It became general about 12 m. and was concluded until about 7 p.m., when the Federals retired, leaving in possession of the field.

Sherman's celebrated Battery of Light Artillery was captured.

It was a terrible battle and was attended with great slaughter on both sides.

DESTRUCTION OF MORE BRIDGES.

A bridge over the Yadkin River, between

today a gang or detachment of Southern cavalry, numbering 100 to 150, who have been riding about in that vicinity for 100 miles, entirely destroyed the bridge on the George's Creek (coal mine) Railroad, in the vicinity of Piedmont, and also on the other railroads within the same vicinity, thus destroying the late connection between Cumberland and Piedmont by rail, which was built by those hands since their conduct in destroying the Baltimore and Ohio railroad bridges. They also yesterday, after destroying a valuable stone arch bridge of the Baltimore and Ohio Railroad, took notice West of Piedmont.

The Battle at Bull Run—North Carolina Completion of the Dispatch.

Wilmington, July 20.

Fall participants from the battle fight at Bull Creek, have been received. It is stated that three companies belonging to the rebels received a killing loss, killing's number, but they stand their ground covering their retreat with a garrison of Seven Guards and Sherman's Battery, the horses of which were disabled. Four regiments, supported by Cavalry, joined the Battery.

The Southerners and their guns well, for the Federal guns were put in position and poured grape and Canister into the Southerners until their ammunition was exhausted.

Several of the Federal guns were disabled. The total loss of the Federals are estimated at 40 killed.

Gen. Taylor ordered the Federals to fall back and Wilson's division was ordered to march back the Bull Creek Battalions.

A Dispatch arrived at the War Department today says that fighting is still going on at Bull Creek.

Information received at the War Department says that the Bull Creek Battery was captured by the enemy, but no particulars are given.

The N. Y. Times says that the Federal loss is killed and wounded amount to 100. This will finish the attack on Manassas, which conflict will occur to-morrow.

The Confederates have won.

Northern thirst for Blood.—The New York politicians are becoming bloodthirsty. The New York Central Republicans Club has adopted resolutions against any compromise "short of the unconditional surrender of every traitor now in arms against the Government, and the confiscation of all his property to meet the heavy expenses of the war, and to compensate those who have heroically periled their lives and their fortunes to sustain the Government."

Northern Consensus.—The Black Republican papers in New York are generally delighted with Lincoln's Message. The Times, however, ridicules it and points out its defects. The Democratic papers, the Journal of Commerce, Day Book and News, attack it directly. "Even the Rebels," says the Richmond Dispatch, "are appalled by the judgment of the people against the conclusions set forth in the Message. Perhaps when the Northern people get their eyes open to the fact that the war will swell up a national debt amounting to an average sum of \$420,000,000 for each and every tax payer in the free States, they will call down the malice of Heaven upon the authors of their ruin and drive them away to the hells and corpos of the earth."

ENEMY OF THE WAR ON JOURNALISM.—The hard times are beginning to show themselves pretty severely among the newspapers, North and South. The country papers are collapsing in every direction, and, in consequence of the lack of advertising, there is a general movement among the dailies in the large cities to reduce their size. The papers in Augusta and Savanah have increased their subscription price. Even the "Metropolitan" journals of New York are shrinking and tailoring before the tempest which they have so long sheltered.

The "Herald" are no longer to be seen. The "Advertiser" and "Inquirer," the notorious organ of James Watson Webb, has collapsed and been absorbed by the lugubrious "World." The "Times" (Seward's organ) has very materially reduced its size.

And all this is but the beginning of the end.—Mercury.

NOTICE

The following resolution was passed during last week at the County Court at Salisbury, for the support of indigent families of persons now in military service:

At a Court of Pleas and Quarter Sessions, begun and held at the Courthouse in Concord, on the 3rd Monday in July, A. D. 1861, a majority of the Justices being present, when Daniel Coleman, Esq., was appointed Chairman, and H. B. Knappinger, Esq., was appointed Secretary, and the following proceedings were had and orders made to-wit:

Ordered by the Court, That for the purpose of rendering aid and support to the indigent families of persons engaged in the military service of the State, that a sum of forty thousand dollars, in such sum, and from time to time, as the Court hereafter may deem necessary, and for the purpose of negotiating said loan, and directing the application of it, the following persons are designated as a committee, to be called the Executive Committee, to wit: R. W. Allison, Esq.; Dr. James F. Gilmer, and James Willford, Esq.

It is further ordered by the Court, That R. W. Allison have leave to negotiate such loan on such terms and in such amounts as he may deem expedient; and Daniel Coleman, Esq., give certificates as aforesaid, countersigned by the Clerk of the County Court, for such amount and cause the amount and date of each certificate, and the name of each person, or corporation to which issued, to be recorded in a book kept for that purpose; and he (the chairman) shall cause said book to be laid before the Justices of the County Court, at every term of said Court, and at any time before the Committee of Finance, when required by the Court or Committee of Finance.

It is further ordered by the Court, That said R. W.
