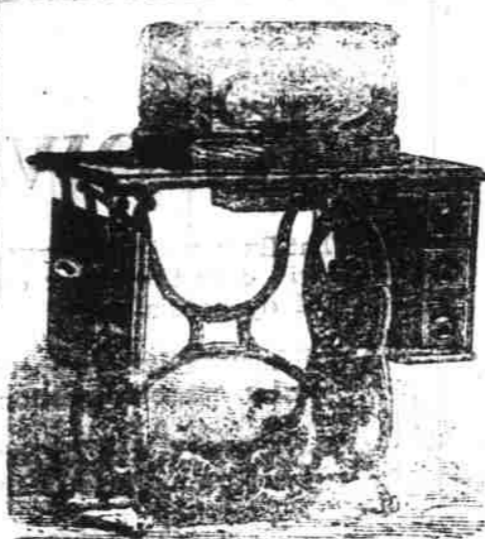

SEINES AND POUNDS.

WE MEASURE THE MESH.

AS PER DIAGRAM.

One Inch Square Mesh.

Parties ordering Netting or Seines, will give the length and depth required when on line. We allow one-third for rigging, that is, if the Seine is to be 100 yds long and 10 feet deep when on line, as per diagram No. 1.

100 YARDS.

We would make the webbing 150 yards long, 15 feet deep when stretched the same as a rope, that is the Mesh stretched as per diagram No. 2.

In the absence of any instruction, we will make as above. In ordering give full description of what you want; leave nothing to be guessed at.
