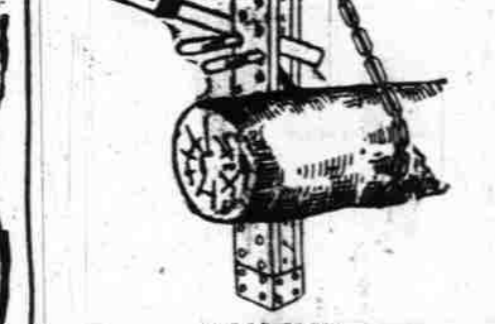

SIMPLE LOG JACK.

Very Useful to Farmers Living in a Timbered Country.

The illustration, which we reengrave from Farm and Home, represents a log jack which among its ingenious farmer can make. It consists of two hard wood planks nailed quite close together. Holes are then drilled in which two iron pegs should slide easily. A lever of hard, tough wood, or of iron, is then required with a short chain and hook. A chain is then hooked to the top of



the plank, passed under the log to be raised and hooked to the chain on the lever. The lever is then worked similarly to a pump handle. When lowering the handle and allowing the weight to rest on the outer pin, move up the pin in front to a hole higher. When the handle is raised with the weight on the front pin, raise the back pin. By this plan a ton may be easily raised by a single person, as the leverage is only half an inch with a 6-foot lever.

FOR HAULING HAY.

A Cheap and simple Rack and some of its Advantages.

The hayrack shown in the illustration is one which I used last summer. It is 10 feet long and 4 feet wide. Two-inch lumber is used for the sides and the latter 1/2 inches in width. Three boards are nailed or bolted on top of the cross pieces on each side of the rack. A 2x4 scantling long enough to reach from the outer edge of the rack to the inside of the boards is bolted edgewise on top of the two hind cross pieces. An inch strip must be placed upon the hind cross piece to bring it up to a level with the one in front of the hind wheel. The cross pieces are now high enough so that when the boards are placed upon them they will be out of the way of the wheel. This makes a rack which is nearly level, being only 4 inches higher behind than in front. This rack is advantageous in that the distance between the cross pieces is smaller at the front end than at the rear end of the rack, thus allowing shorter turns than when they are made parallel. In

order to keep the rack in place a false bolster is bolted to it which fits on to the front bolster of the wagon. The false bolster is made of hard wood. In front the sills are 10 1/2 inches apart from outside to outside, the distance at the other end being 30 inches. This represents the roller upon which the front ladder is erected; B B the rear ends of the sills; a false bolster; and b simply the hind bolster of the wagon. The lower figure to the right represents the front ladder. The lower figure to the left represents the hind ladder which should not be more than 3 1/2 feet high in case a hay loader is to be used. It is simply bolted to the sills.—Orange Judd Farmer.

ROTATION OF CROPS.

Composition of Soils and Way to Maintain Their Fertility.

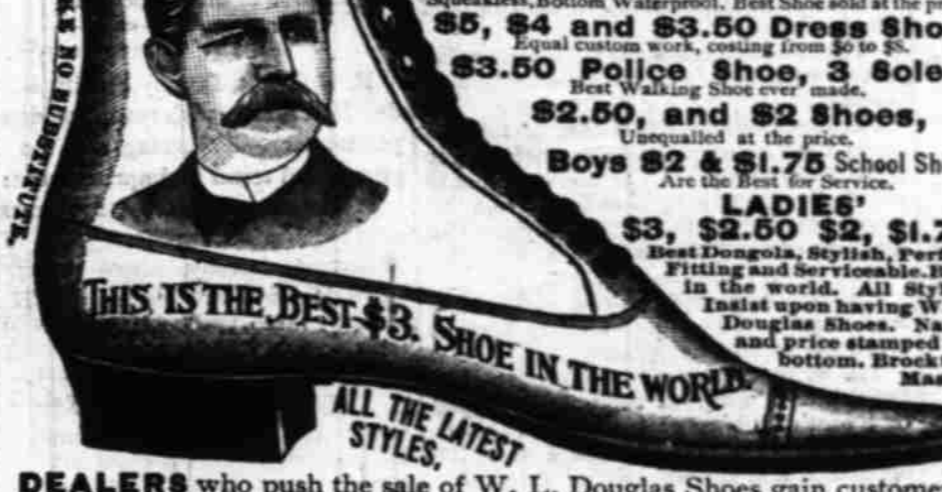
