

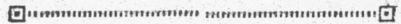

Mrs. L. J. Keels has returned from Chester, S. C.



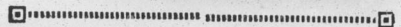

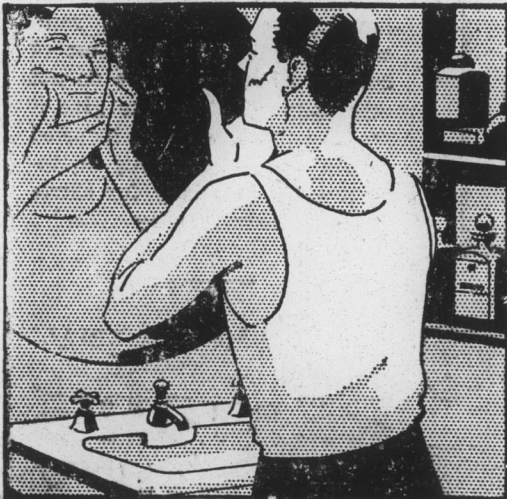
