Mrs. A. M. Graham of Rockhill, S. C., has taken the Battleship house in the valley for the summer.

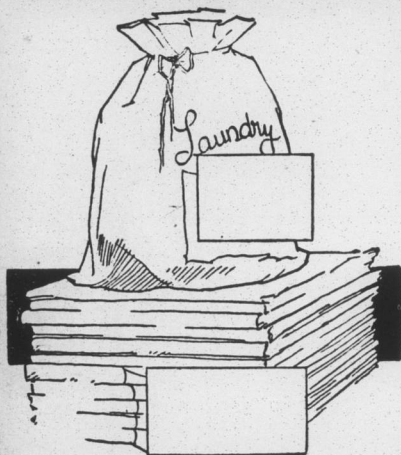
