Hendersonville, Sept. 6.—Horace Drake, who escaped from the Henderson county jail here about two a. In weeks ago, was recaptured by the sheriff's department Friday about daybreak at the home of his mother west of Hendersonville.

Officers who made the arrest are Roy Owens, Donald Hill and Jerry Orr. Drake, officers said, ran to the attic of the house broke thru the ceiling, and fell to a room below. He then attempted to jump through a window, but was captured.

Agaiting trial on charges of housebreaking, Drake escaped about two weeks ago by breaking through a part of the brick wall with a bar of iron lowering himself to the ground with sheets tied together. He has been returned to the jail.—Asheville Citizen.
