Mrs. T. T. Ballenger

News has been received in Tryon of the death of Mrs. T. T. Ballenger at 12:15 last night in Atlanta, Ga. where she had made her home for over 20 years. Her husband, the late Senator T. T. Ballenger passed away last March. Funeral services will be held on Tuesday afternoon in Atlanta.

The deceased is survived by three children, Register of Deeds, C. W. Ballenger of Tryon, Dr. E. G. Ballenger and Mrs. Juliette Moseley of Atlanta and Richard Ballenger of Hickory; also the following grandchildren, Prof. Stanley Ballenger of Raleigh, Theodore Ballenger of Tryon, Garrison Ballenger of Memphis, Mrs. Marshall Foster and Mrs. John Barlett of Atlanta.

Mrs. Ballenger who was in her 80th year was the daughter of the late Mr. and Mrs. John Garrison, pioneer citizens of Tryon who lived in what is now the Pacolet Plantation which was part of a large grant of land from the king of England to Mrs. Garrison's ancestors.

Mrs. Ballenger visited Tryon just a short while ago. Death followed a stroke a few days ago. She was well-known and loved by a host of friends.
