

Duke Hospital Awards Made

Charlotte, April 1.—A total of \$76,799.65 was allotted to orphanages and hospitals in Western North Carolina yesterday by trustees of the Duke Endowment.

Among the allotments were the following: Lyday Memorial hospital, Brevard, \$684; Mountain Sanitarium, Fletcher, \$1,676; Patton Memorial, Hendersonville, \$1,225; St. Luke's, Tryon, \$1,500; Spartanburg Baby Hospital, Saluda, \$2,848.

A total of \$962,499.22 was appropriated for hospitals and orphanages in North and South Carolina.
