During the nine months period just ended on October 1, the Tryon Post Office showed an increase in postal receipts of \$1,516.77 according to Postmaster W. H. Stearns. Receipts for nine months during the same period last year were \$10,508.21. Receipts so far this year have amounted to \$12,024.98.
