

4 Amendments Are Favored By Both Nominees

Raleigh, Oct. 22.—Both of North Carolina's gubernatorial candidates issued statements today endorsing the four proposed "tax reform" amendments to the state constitution.

Clyde R. Hoey, Democratic candidate, endorsed also the fifth proposed change — an amendment which would empower the general assembly to increase the membership of the state supreme court from five to seven.

Gilliam Grissom, epublican, did not comment on the supreme court amendment.

Gilliam Grissom, Republican, did "The homestead exemption amendment is the greatest inducement I have heard to encourage home ownership . . . the classification of property for taxation seems thoroughly equitable . . . income tax is the fairest basis to levy tax . . . debt-limitation cannot be made too stringent."

Hoey said in part:

"I shall vote for each of the constitutional amendments to be submitted to the people of the state in the November election. I am not unmindful of the objections raised and the arguments advanced against each of them, but taken as a whole I am persuaded that these amendments will enable the legislature to deal with vexed problems of taxation in such a way as to work out a more equitable and just system of taxation."
