Tryon Bank Shows Splendid Report

The report of the Tryon Bank & Trust Co., in this issue of the Bulletin is the best that has been published so far and shows the continued growth of the institution which is serving the banking needs of the county. The total resources have passed the \$600,000 mark and over \$160,000 is loaned out now to meet the needs of business. The bank has a surplus of \$35,000. Out of nearly 300 state banks in North Carolina there are only nine who are members of the Federal Reserve System and one of the nine is the Tryon Bank & Trust Co. The officers are E. E.
