Would Prohibit Absentee Ballot In Polk County

Raleigh, Jan. 15.—Senator F. P. Bacon, Polk, introduced a bill in the senate today to exempt Polk county from the provisions of the absentee ballot law insofar as it applies to county officers.

His measure is patterned after similiar legislation adopted in 1935 for Haywood county and in 1931 for Buncombe county. Use of the absentee ballot would be permitted in primaries and general elections for national, state and legislative offices, but would be prohibited for all county offices.

The bill was referred to the senate committee on election laws headed by Senator Kelly E. Bennett of Swain county. Senator Bacon is a member of this committee.—Asheville Citizen.
