## Annual Tryon Gymkhana Will Be Held Today

Tryon, April 3. — The annual spring Gymkhana wili be held on (today) Saturday afternoon at Harmon Field, sponsored by the Tryon Riding & Hunt club, with a small admission fee charged for the benefit of the Polk county Helping Hand association.

Games and races will be held on horseback, in which a large number of young people home for spring holidays are expected to varticipate. This event will be purely for enjoyment, although ribbons will be awarded to the winners.

The Gymkhana will be held at 2:30 this afternoon.

This occasion will be the last af its kind until the 12th annual forse and Hound Show, to be held this year on April 14 at Harmon Field. Plans are nearing completion for the event, which is expicted to be the largest and best attended of any held here. Letters have been received from sporting associations all over the country stating their intention of sending representatives to the show. Horses and riders will come from Fort Oglethorpe, Ga., as in other years to compete with local and tourist riders, and an unusually colorful show is expected.
