SOCIAL SECURITY NUMBERS REQUIRED OF STUDENTS

Raleigh. June 17 .- All emp oyees, even students working for the summer and those doing occasion. al work, are required to secure Social Security acount numbers through the local postoffice. Those who reached 65 years of age before last January 1 are not eligible to participate in old age benefits, under the Federal program, but if they continue work after that age, they should have numbers for the State Unemployment Compensation records, Chairman Charles Powell reminds. Both the employer and employee are required to see that they have numbers before July 1.
