The New York Hospital Nursing School has its origin in a course of training for nurses given from 1799 to 1817 by Dr. Valentine Seaman, a famous surgeon of his His course of lectures. supplemented by practical instruction in the wards of The New York Hospital, was probably the first systematic and scientific training offered to nurses anywhere.

The present school, however, was not established until 1877. It moved to its magnificent new building, overlooking the East River in 1932. It is part of The New York Hospital Medical Center which also includes Cornell University Medical College. The bospital, with capacity for 1,000 patients, offers unusual facilities for teaching nursing students in its medical, surgical - operating room (pediatrics, obsterical, gyne-cological, psychiatric, public health, and out-patient departments.
