ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING \$8,000 REFUNDING BONDS

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Commissioners of the Town of Tryon, North Carolina, as follows:

Section 1. That the Town of Tryon issue its bonds pursuant to the MUNICIPAL FINANCE ACT, as amended in an amount not exceeding \$8,000.00 for the purpose of refunding and paying a like

amount of principal of valid subsisting bonded inceptedness due as shown by the schedule below which indebtedness was incurred for necessary expenses of the said town and is evidenced by the following:

\$4,000 Street Improvement Bonds dated April 1, 1922, due April 1, 1939, payable at National City Bank, New York.

\$4,000 Water Bonds, dated April 1, 1926, due April 1, 1939, payable at National City Bank, No... York

Section 2. That a tax sufficient to pay the principal and interest of said bonds shall be levied and collected.

Section 3. That a statement of the debt of the Town has been filed with the Clerk and is open to public inspection.

Section 4. That this Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and shall not be submitted to the voters.

The foregoing ordinance was passed on the 11th day of July, 1938, and was first published on the 20th day of September, 1938.

Any action or proceeding questioning the validity of said Ordinance must be commenced within thirty days after its first publication.
