Raleigh, March 7.—The state house of representatives completed committee-of-the-whole consideration of the revenue bill tonight and passed the measure on first reading. The representatives killed a score or more amendments to the record-setting tax bill, which is designed to finance a \$154,350,000 spending program during 1939-
