Local Rat Trap Story Gets National Notice

The following Rat Trap story which appeared in The Polk County News recently and later in other state papers is being sent out over the world by the Associated Press from the Raleigh office. Mrs. Edith Missildine Columbus finds it in the Duluth, Minn., Herald as follows:

"Raleigh, N. C., Aug. 28.—If this story gets around, the world may beat a path to the door of E. G. Edney, farmer of the Pacolet valley community in Polk county.

"J. A. Wilson, Polk county farm agent, reported that Edney set a rat trap and covered the trigger with "mash", or cowfeed. The rodents gathered about the trap in a semi-circle for a feast, and when the trap was sprung, five rats were killed.

"Wilson said that at the same time Edney caught two 'granddaddy' rats in another trap."
