Mrs. Martha Dedmondt, wife of Mr. E. W. Dedmondt, died at her home in Columbus at 3 a. m., this morning (Thursday) after a lingering illness. She was 77 years old.

Mrs. Dedmondt, the former Martha Washington Lookado, was born in the eastern part of North Carolina, and was married to Mr. Dedmondt December 11th, 1879. They celebrated their 60th wedding anniversary Sunday, December 10th, at which time Mrs. Dedmondt was confined to her bed by an attack of pneumonia which resulted in her death.

The deceased is survived by her husband, two sons, George C. of Tryon and Esby Von Dedmondt of Newberry, S. C.; three daughters, Mrs. A. D. Brown of Prosperity, S. C.; Mrs. J. L. Furr, Clinton, S. C., and Mrs. W. A. Ormand of Columbus; seventeen grandchildren and several great-grandchildren also survive.
