## Hit By Train

Frank Gosnell, about 22, son of Mr. and Mrs. Lem Gosnell, was found early this morning lying in a ditch near the railroad track west of Tryon. He had a severe scalp wound, but was conscious when found. Frank had started home after 10:30 Friday night. One shoe, a flash light and handkerchief were found strewed along the track, indicating that Frank had probably sat down and pulled off his shoe and was hit by a train. He was still conscious this morning at St. Luke's hospital.

## BURRELL UNDER BOND ON ASSAULT CHARGES

Archie Burrell, Tryon Police man, posted bond of \$500 before Magistrate J. A. Burns of Columbus Township early this week for his appearance at the August term of Superior Court to face charges of "assault with a deadly weapon". The warrant was issued by Magistrate Burns and signed by Sheriff W. D. Hines.

The charges grew out of alleged injuries to Melvin Hines, son of Sheriff Hines when Melvin was arrested by Burrell on Trade street early this year. Young Hines was confined to St. Luke's hospital for treatment for several days.
